



VIOLENCE AND TAILINGS DAMS

The Doce River case

- November, 2015
- Samarco (Vale + BHP Billiton)
- Dam capacity 60 million m3
- Contamination of 660 km along the riverbed + coastal area
- 19 deaths
- Forced resettlement of 500 families
- Agreement involving federal and state governments, judiciary institutions and mining company
- Reparation by private trust (Fundação Renova)
- Collective action in the UK

The Paraopeba River case

- January, 2019
- Vale
- Dam capacity 11 million m3
- Contamination of 360 km along the riverbed
- 270 deaths
- Agreement involving state government, judiciary institutions and mining company
- Reparation by the mining company





Today I received feedback from the staff of a large mining company. They requested to be allowed to extend the deadline by three months for the release of tailings into a pit. Oh, I won't give it for three months. Because it does not make sense. If this launch was already allowed, if all the technical conditions were already met, why only three months? Why not a year? In three months, they will apply again. And they were happy, and it worked out. (Production Superintended, National Mining Agency)

Year	Company	Municipality	Description
1986	Itaminas	Itabirito	Dam burst causing seven deaths
2001	Mineração Rio Verde	Nova Lima	Dam burst causing silting of 6,4 km of Taquaras stream and five deaths
2006	Rio Pomba Cataguases	Miraí	Overflow of 1.200.000 m ³ of tailings polluting streams, killing fish and disrupting water supply
2007	Rio Pomba Cataguases	Miraí	Dam burst, release of 2.280.000 m ³ of tailing flooding the cities of Miraí e Muriaé and displacing 4.000 people.
2008	CSN	Congonhas	Failure of the spillway of the dam, increasing the volume of the Maranhão river and displacing 40 families.
2008	N/D	Itabira	Dam failure with overflow of chemical tailings of gold mining
2014	Herculano Mineração	Itabirito	Dam burst causing three deaths.

"Although it is considered of moderate risk, because it is improbable, we have identified an event with catastrophic consequences. It relates to the dam burst with cumulative effects over the Santarém dam. It is recommended a quantitative study to mode this event and precisely identify its consequences, particularly over the Bento Rodrigues community" (Brandt, 2005 p. 217)

Ineffective environmental policy Córrego do Feijão Dam environmental permit

[...] the SUPPRI technical team understands that the activities were not listed in in SISEMA Instruction 01/2018 but [...] that it can be redirected to LAC1 [...] " (SUPPRI, 2018)

"Although the locational criteria direct the project to LAC2, the SUPPRI technical team understands that [...] it can be reoriented to LAC1" (SUPPRI, 2018)

More than 140 jurists and organizations request the immediate removal of Mariana disaster case judge $\,$

More than 140 jurists, researchers and politicians sign an open letter in which they request the immediate removal of the substitute judge Mário de Paula Franco Júnior from the Samarco Case.

The letter is based on the revelations made by the Mining Observatory in March 2021 that motivated the judge's request for suspicion formalized by five institutions - Public Prosecutor's Office, Public Prosecutor's Office of Minas Gerais, Public Defender's Office, Public Defender's Office of Minas Gerais and Espírito Santo - In the end of the last month.

"The seriousness of the facts revealed to the Brazilian society about the procedural conduct in this case requires that the conduct be investigated seriously, with the immediate appointment of a judge or a substitute judge, in view of the pressing danger of irreparable damage to these already tired victims", says the letter, which was also signed by institutions including social movements, NGOs, research centers and legal organizations.

Intentional legal loopholing

- Decommissioning of upstream dams
 - Resolution 04/2019: 2021
 - Resolution 13/2019: 2027
 - Act 14.066/2020: 2022
 - The monitoring agency may postpone the deadline




Figura 7 – Distribuição temporal da previsão de conclusão das obras de descaracterização das barragens a montante.

- The monitoring agency may demand financial assurance
- Safety inspections must be carried out by external staff, hired by the mining companies.
 - When communities live immediately downstream from a dam, the dam may be decommissioned or suffer reinforcement, or the community may be resettled, depending on economic feasibility and recommendation by the mining company
